Costumes for our School Production – IMPORTANT REMINDER

The costumes are very simple:

Children in years K-2 will be performing a dance during the performance. Their costumes need to be as follows (see picture right):

Girls: pale pink leotard (long sleeves or short sleeves) and headband.

Boys: plain white T-shirt (thigh length) and two pairs of tights any colour.

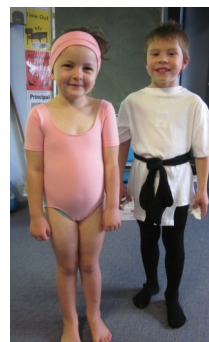


Merry Men (left): long plain green or plain brown T-shirt or shirt (down to mid thigh or knee) brown or green tights or leggings; and a belt.

Soldiers (right): long plain white T-shirt (down to mid-thigh or knee) - with a red cross on front if possible; brown or red tights or leggings; and a belt.
