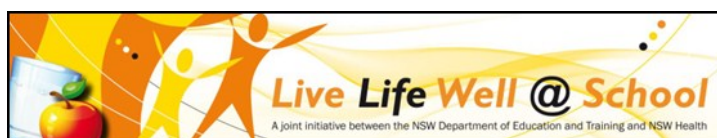


## Where in the World is Bucket Head?
