### P&C Greyhound Fundraiser Night

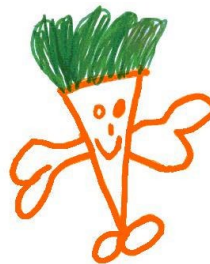
