Important Notice to Parents

Please could we remind parents and carers who collect students from school at the end of the day to arrive between 3.00pm-3.10pm and to wait at the benches under the Infant shelter until the bell rings. This is to minimise disruption to class lessons. Can I also remind parents that if you are entering the school grounds before 3.00pm (for a pre-arranged appointment with a staff member or as a volunteer) that it is important that you sign in at the front office and obtain a 'Visitor' badge. Thank you for your support and helping to keep our school a safe place.

Contacting the School

Most general enquiries at school go through the school office, either in person or via phone. However, sometimes parents and carers need specific information relating to their child. The first person to contact should be your child's class teacher as they can answer most queries. Should you need to escalate an enquiry, you will be directed to the Assistant Principal for your child's Stage. Class teachers and Assistant Principals are usually available for brief meetings at the beginning and end of each school day (it is advisable to make an appointment if you require more time to discuss a matter). Assistant Principals for each Stage are:

Ms. Abeleven (Year 5 and Year 6)
