Chloe has been invited to attend the special awards ceremony in Sydney to receive her certificate from His Excellency General The Honourable David Hurley, former Governor of NSW. Over 6000 entries were received from 169 schools



across the State, with each entry focusing on the importance of putting an end to bullying. Interrelate's Bullying Awareness Program aims to reduce bullying and enhance children's emotional and social wellbeing by offering strategies and tips for dealing with bullies.

Easter Assembly



