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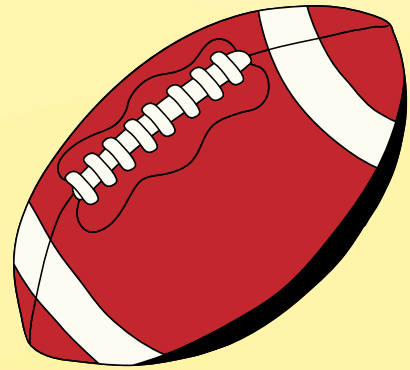
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Brian Kelly Legend 7s Rugby Gala Day

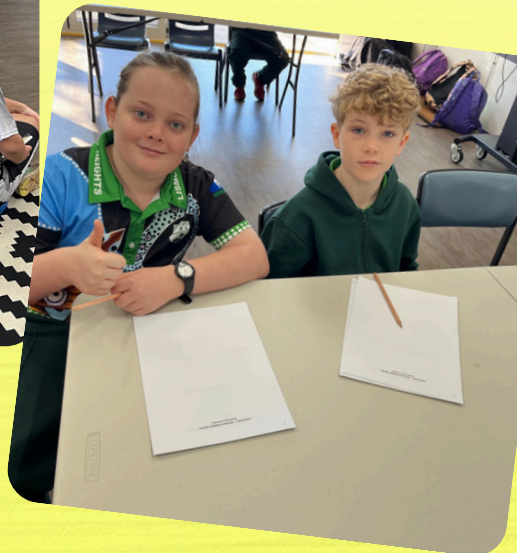


PSSA Touch Football Recap
